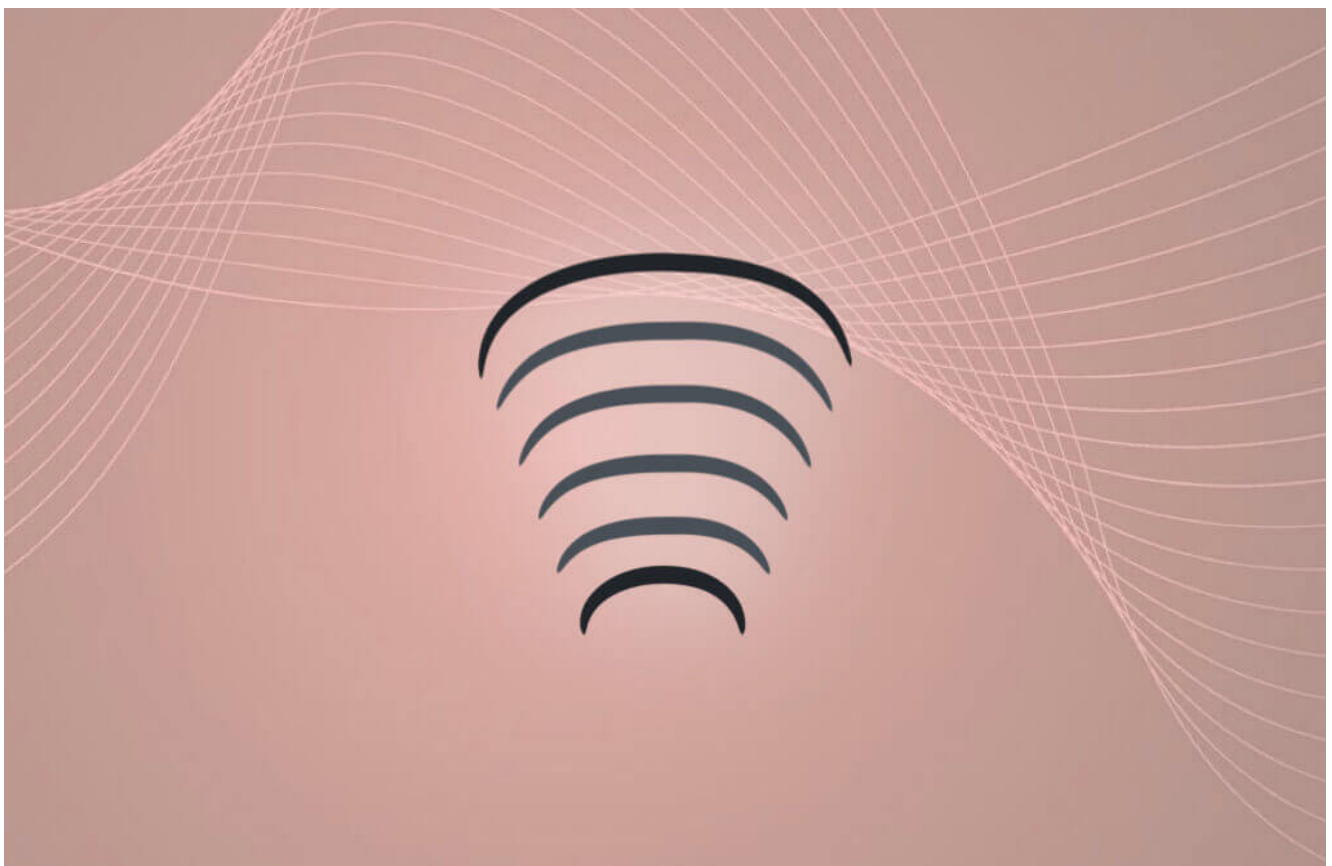


Tips & Tricks: Exploring New Curve Editing Features from Rhino 8 to Rhino WIP

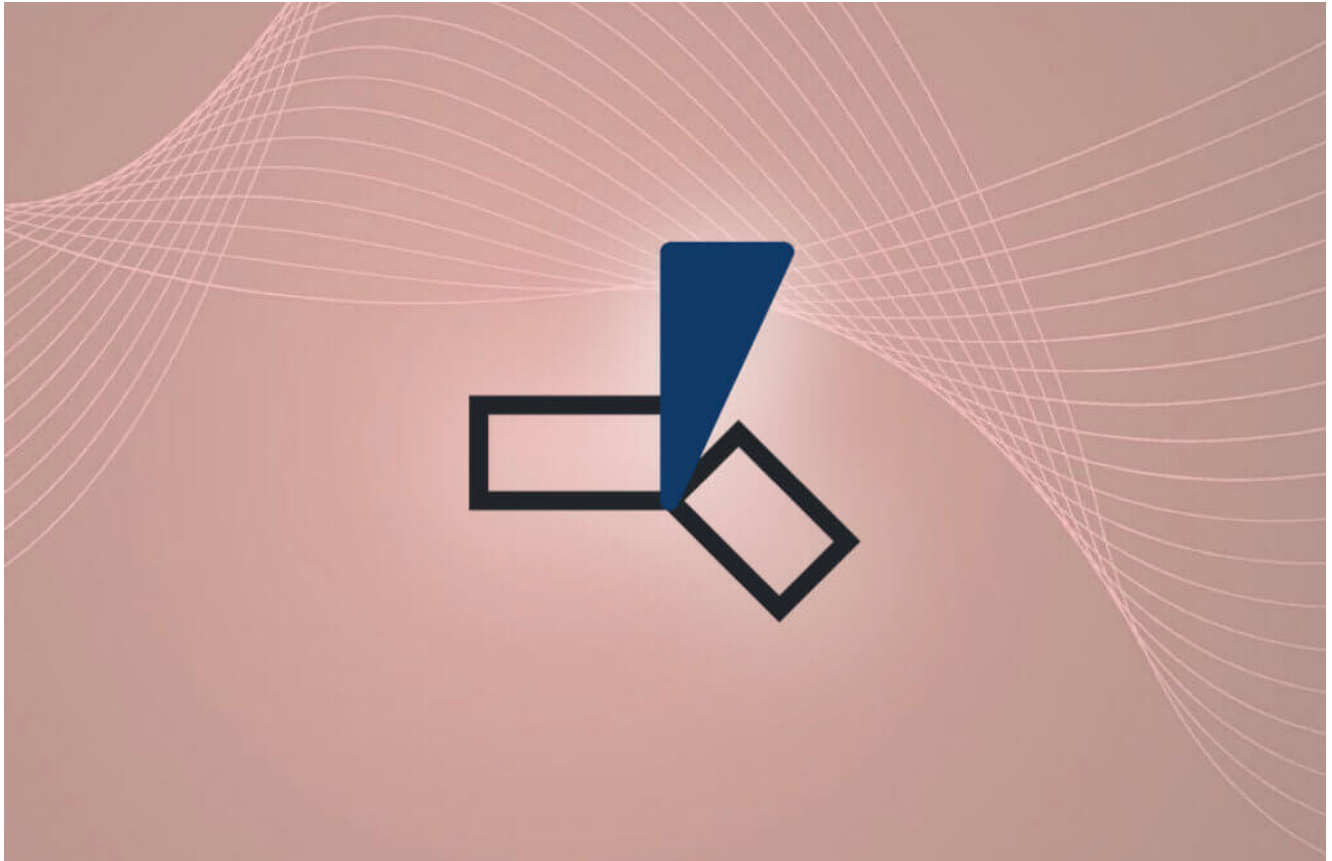
Working with curves is a fundamental task in [Rhino](#), and [Rhino](#) WIP introduces some handy improvements to make curve creation and editing faster and more intuitive. In this guide, we explore a workflow that starts in Rhino 8 and transitions into Rhino 9 to take advantage of powerful new tools like Instant Aliases and the Fence option in the Trim command.

[1. Creating Curves Using the Between Curves Command in Rhino 8](#)



Rhino 8 offers a versatile *Between Curves* command that lets you quickly create new curves connecting existing ones. This is useful for generating smooth transitional shapes and complex profiles.

[2. Challenges Trimming Curves in Rhino 8](#)



After generating your curves, trimming them to refine the shape can become tedious, especially when working with multiple overlapping curves or intricate shapes.

[3. Upgrade to Rhino WIP for Streamlined Curve Editing](#)

If you have Rhino 8, consider downloading the Rhino 9 Work In Progress (WIP) version to explore exciting new features that simplify curve editing tasks.

[4. Discover Instant Aliases and Fence Trim in Rhino](#) WIP

Rhino 9 introduces [Instant Aliases](#), a quick way to access commands and shortcuts, speeding up your workflow by reducing menu navigation.

Even more impactful is the *Fence* option inside the Trim command. This allows you to trim multiple curves in one go by drawing a fence line across them, a huge time saver compared to trimming each curve individually.

Type:	#	Description
A	1	Right rest arm
B	1	Left rest arm
C	5	Front legs, back support
D	7	Seat and back support
E	2	Vertical back support
F	2	Horizontal legs
